ORDINANCE NO. 9725

AN ORDINANCE granting an extension of preliminary approval for the Planned Unit Development of CEDAR DOWNS VILLAGE

BALD File No. 230-87-P

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Findings. The council finds that:

A. The applicant has filed a written request for an extension of twelve months for preliminary planned unit development approval.

B. The applicant has complied with and met the provisions of the King County code.

C. The applicant has made substantial progress in complying with the conditions of preliminary approval.

D. It would be inequitable to require the applicant to reapply.

SECTION 2. Preliminary approval for the planned unit development of Cedar Downs Village

(BALD File No. 230-87-P) is granted an extension to expire on November 5, 1991.
