ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE relating to fees charged for the use of King County Parks and Recreation facilities and amending Ordinance 9227, and K.C.C. 7.08.020.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Swimming pool facilities (except King County Aquatics Center). Swimming pool facilities fees shall be:

A. Swimming pool fees (fees include sales tax)

Public Swims: \$1.00 per person per session

Sixty Cent Swims60 per person per session

Adult Only Swims 1.60 per person per session

Senior citizens-60 years plus - \$1.00 per person for any

program session.

B. Swim lessons: \$100 per half hour to \$10.00 per half hour

C. Pool rentals

1. Private rentals

25 persons or less \$27.50 per hour

26 - 60 persons 37.50 per hour

61 - 90 persons 50.00 per hour

91 - 120 persons 60.00 per hour

121 - 150 persons 75.00 per hour

2. Special interest groups 21.50 per hour

3. School districts 15.00 per hour

4. King County Park Swim Teams

When sharing the pool 12.00 per hour

When using the entire pool 18.00 per hour

D. Family membership program (entitles member to all public swims and adults to all adult swims, including the Recreation Pool in the King County Aquatic Center).

1. Three Months

Youth 17 years or younger . . . \$32.50 plus sales tax

Adults, 18 years or older . . . 54.00 plus sales tax

1 Family, 2 or more 78.00 plus sales tax
2 Senior citizens, 60 years or older - \$32.50 plus
3 sales tax.

4 2. Yearly
5 Youth 17 years or younger . . \$85.00 plus sales tax
6 Adults, 18 years or older . . 140.00 plus sales tax
7 Family, 2 or more 208.00 plus sales tax
8 Senior citizens, 60 years or older - \$65.00 plus
9 sales tax.

10 E. Locker Fees \$0.25 per locker

11 F. Individuals with physical or developmental disabilities
12 shall receive the same rate as senior citizens.

13 G. Individuals with physical or developmental disabilities
14 shall provide documented proof of disability to qualify for
15 reduced fees.

16 H. Individual youths, 17 years or younger who can document
17 their eligibility for free or reduced price school meals as
18 established by the U.S. Department of Agriculture and
19 thereafter revised shall qualify for free or reduced fee public
20 swims.

22 of October, 1990.
