

ORDINANCE NO. **9941**

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$2,061,528 to the County Road Fund (Fund 1030) to pay for 1990 flood damage contracts and windstorm damages; transferring \$140,000 to establish a CIP Project for 196th Avenue SE; amending Ordinance No. 9720, Sections 59 and 94, as amended.

PREAMBLE:

On Friday, November 23, 1990, the Northwest was inundated by a severe rainstorm. Record rainfall in the Cascades and throughout the Puget Sound region caused the existing snowpack to melt, swelling rivers beyond flood stage. Severe flood damage was reported throughout the Puget Sound region.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$2,061,528 to Roads Operating in the County Road Fund (Fund 1030) to pay for flood damage contracts and windstorm damage, from Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) grant revenues in the amount of \$1,052,600, Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) grant revenues in the amount of \$457,968 and the County Road Fund unencumbered fund balance in the amount of \$550,960.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 9720, Section 59, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

ROADS OPERATING - From the County Road Fund there is hereby appropriated to:

Roads Operating \$2,061,528

SECTION 3. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$140,000 to 196th Avenue SE, CIP Project No. 400491, within the County Road Construction Fund from a transfer from the Cost Model Contingency, CIP Project 999386, to provide flood repairs.
