ORDINANCE NO. **9948**

AN ORDINANCE establishing a "Local
Hazardous Waste Fund" and adding a new
section to K.C.C. 4.08.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby added to K.C.C. 4.08 a new
section to read as follows: Local Hazardous Waste Fund.

A. There is hereby established a Local Hazardous Waste
Fund for the sole purpose of accumulating and disbursing
financial resources for the implementation of the Local
Hazardous Waste Management Program as described in the Local
Hazardous Waste Management Plan for Seattle-King County.

B. The King County Board of Health and/or its designated
representative shall be responsible for the administration of
the Local Hazardous Waste Fund including the preparation and
issuance of operating procedures deemed necessary to insure the
proper administrative implementation of the policies governing
the purpose and use of the fund.

C. The Local Hazardous Waste Fund shall be classified as
a first tier fund. All amounts designated by the Board within
the rate structure of the fee system as earmarked for the Local
Hazardous Waste Fund shall be collected as prescribed by the
rate structure. These earmarked funds shall be transferred and
credited to the Local Hazardous Waste Fund within thirty-five
(35) days of the end of the quarter in which the solid waste
and/or sewage disposal action occurred.

1 D. All earnings derived from specific investment of funds
2 accumulated in the Local Hazardous Waste Fund shall be
3 deposited and credited to the Local Hazardous Waste Fund.

4 E. King County indirect overhead cost allocation charges
5 shall not be levied directly against this fund.
