AN ORDINANCE repealing section 14 of Ordinance
5 No. 9940 and declaring an emergency.

PREAMBLE:

Ordinance No. 9940 passed May 13, 1991, authorized the
8 issuance of sale of King County Road Improvement District
9 No. 102 bonds and contained inconsistent sections 14 and
10 15 with respect to the effective date of the Ordinance.
11 On the belief that Ordinance No. 9940 was effective when
12 passed, a notice of bond sale was circulated calling for
sealed bids for the bonds to be presented to the council
at 10:00 a.m., May 20, 1991. To comply with the terms of
such notice, no bid for the bonds may be accepted unless
said ordinance is fully effective prior to council
consideration of such bids.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Repealer. Section 14 of Ordinance No. 9940 passed
15 May 13, 1991, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. The county finds as a fact and declares that an
17 emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the
18 immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the
19 support of county government and its existing public institutions.
