ORDINANCE NO. 10061

AN ORDINANCE denying the appeal of the vacation of a portion of H. Steen Road (103rd Avenue Southwest) in Council District No. 8 - V-2066. Petitioners: Ala M. Smith, Gary Nathanson and Others

STATEMENT OF FACTS

1. The King County department of public works reviewed the petition to vacate a portion of H. Steen Road (103rd Avenue Southwest) and determined that potential public use exists for the proposed vacation area.

2. The department of public works recommended denial of the vacation request.

3. The petitioners appealed this recommendation before the King County council's transportation and public works committee on December 18, 1990.

4. The committee, hearing testimony from the Executive Board of the Vashon-Maury Community Council, the Vashon Park District Trails Advisory Committee, Commissioners of the Vashon-Maury Island Park and Recreation District and the Commissioners and Fire Chief of Vashon Island Fire District No. 13, voted to deny the appeal and directed council staff to prepare a motion denying the appeal of vacation request V-2066.

5. Motion No. 8216, instructing the executive to prepare and submit to the county council an ordinance denying the appeal of road vacation V-2066, was passed by the King County council on March 4, 1991.

Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the King County council on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of August, 1991.

In consideration of the benefits to be lost by granting the subject vacation, the council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King County to deny the appeal of vacation V-2066.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The council, on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of August, 1991, hereby denies the appeal to vacate and abandon the following described portion of H. Steen Road (103rd Avenue Southwest):

That portion of Section 19, Township 23 North, Range 3 East, W.M., King County, Washington described as follows:
