ORDINANCE NO. **10103**

AN ORDINANCE making a supplemental appropriation of \$200,000 to the Stadium Operating Fund.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$200,000 to the Stadium Operating Fund from the unappropriated Stadium Operating fund balance to provide support for the purchase of baseball tickets, pursuant to the use agreement executed between King County and the Seattle Mariners Baseball Club.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 9720, Section 80 is hereby amended to read as follows:

From the Stadium Operating Fund there is hereby appropriated to Stadium Operating ((~~\$8,631,945~~)) \$8,831,945.

Provided that:

\$15,000 of the \$50,000 appropriation for the North Parking Lot feasibility study shall not be expended until the council approves a progress report on the project.

Provided further that:

It is the intent of the council that said funds shall be spent no later than October 6, 1991 and only to support the retention of the Seattle Mariners Baseball Club in King County, and further shall be spent only upon the written certification of the county executive that funds from all non-county sources spent for this purpose when combined with the county funds hereby appropriated (and in a ratio of at least two non-county dollars for each county dollar to be spent) are sufficient to purchase the number of baseball tickets equivalent to ninety percent of the average American League paid attendance for the 1991 regular baseball season.

Provided further, the executive is encouraged to purchase childrens and general admission tickets for distribution to

1 youth, elderly, needy and disabled or disadvantaged citizens
2 through non-profit organizations.
