2 AN ORDINANCE waiving the competitive
3 bidding requirements of RCW Chapter 36.32
4 for necessary alterations to the Washington
5 Center Building, and declaring an
6 emergency.

7 STATEMENT OF FACTS:

8 1. The King County division of alcoholism and
9 substance abuse services (DASAS) is contracted with
10 the Washington Department of Social and Health
11 Services (DSHS) to operate a program of alcohol and
12 drug detoxification services.

13 2. On August 21, 1991, DASAS received a report
14 presenting the findings of an unannounced on-site
15 evaluation of the detoxification program conducted by
16 DSHS which identified health and safety deficiencies
17 requiring immediate corrective actions.

18 3. Such corrective actions include Capital
19 Improvement Projects and Capital Outlays which must
20 be substantially completed by December 15, 1991.

21 4. The detoxification center occupies two floors
22 of the Washington Center Building for which 1991
23 Capital Improvement Project funds have previously
24 been appropriated and, subsequent to the purchase of
25 the Washington Center Building, for which additional
26 funds are currently available.

27 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

28 SECTION 1. The King County council declares that an
29 emergency exists whereby the public interest would suffer
30 damage or injury by delay if necessary alterations to
31 facilities are not substantially completed by December 15,
32 1991.

33 SECTION 2. Pursuant to the provisions of RCW 36.32.270,
34 the requirements of RCW Chapter 36.32 are hereby waived with
35 regard to the contract or contracts for such alterations to the
36 facility.

1 SECTION 3. The county council finds as a fact and declares
2 that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary
3 for the immediate preservation of public peace, health, or
4 safety or for the support of county government and its existing
5 public institutions.

6 INTRODUCED AND READ for the first time this 23rd day
7 of September, 1991.
