ORDINANCE NO. **10128**

AN ORDINANCE relating to private property and public safety, prohibiting vehicular trespass, and specifying penalties.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Avoidance of stop signs and stop lights

prohibited. No one driving a motor vehicle shall seek to avoid stopping for stop signs, stop lights, yield signs or any other sign or device used to control traffic using a public right-of-way by detouring through private property to reach any other public or private right-of-way.

SECTION 2. Penalty. Anyone found to be in violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of an infraction punishable by a fine of no more than twenty five dollars.
