AN ORDINANCE making supplemental appropriations of \$103,575 to District Court Acquisition and Development Fund - Shoreline District Court; and amending Ordinance 9720, Section 94, Attachment 1, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$103,575 to CIP Project No. 999397, Transfer to Fund 331, from the unappropriated fund balance of the District Court Acquisition and Construction Fund for the purpose of funding increased costs of building the Shoreline District Court.

SECTION 2. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$103,575 to the Building Modernization and Construction Fund, Capital Improvement Project No. 665502 - Shoreline District Court, for the purpose of supporting unanticipated site work costs and the associated consultant and monitoring work required for over-excavation work.

SECTION 3. Ordinance 9720, Section 94, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

From the several capital improvement project funds there are hereby appropriated and authorized to be disbursed the following amounts for the specific projects identified in Attachment No. 1 of this ordinance.
