ORDINANCE NO. **10178**

AN ORDINANCE establishing a Criminal Justice Fund providing for the receipt and disbursement of criminal justice revenues.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby created a Criminal Justice Fund effective as of January 1, 1991. This fund shall be a second tier fund as described in 4.10.010 of the King County Code. The director or deputy budget director shall be the fund manager.

SECTION 2. The Criminal Justice Fund shall be used for the receipt and disbursement of revenues related to the funding of the criminal justice system addressed by the Washington State Legislature in the 1990 2nd extraordinary session and any other revenues related specifically to the criminal justice system addressed by the Washington State Legislature or the King County Council. The acquisition or construction of major capital facilities funded in whole or in part by criminal justice revenue shall be accounted for in a capital projects fund. The Criminal Justice Fund shall reimburse the capital projects fund for its criminal justice expenditures by operating transfer.

1 SECTION 3. Authority is hereby granted to transfer any  
2 remaining balance of 1990 receipts of criminal justice revenue  
3 from the Current Expense Fund to the Criminal Justice Fund.
