AN ORDINANCE extending the excise tax on telephone access lines in King County for operation of an enhanced 911 emergency telephone system, and amending Ordinance 6875, Section 6, and K.C.C. 4.34.060.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 6875, Section 6, as amended, and K.C.C. 4.34.060 is hereby amended to read as follows: The excise tax on the use of all telephone access lines in King County as approved by the voters of King County in November 1981 for the purpose of paying for the implementation and operation of an enhanced 911 emergency telephone system is hereby extended ((The tax imposed by this chapter)) and shall be effective from and after January 1 ((1990)) 1992 until December 31, ((1991)) 1995.
