ORDINANCE NO. 10208

1
2 AN ORDINANCE making a supplemental
3 appropriation of \$469,564 to the Safety
4 and Worker's Compensation Fund from the
5 unencumbered fund balance to cover
6 unanticipated Worker's Compensation
7 Industrial Insurance Program costs, and
8 amending Ordinance 9720, Section 81, as
9 amended.

10 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

11 SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted a
12 supplemental appropriation of \$469,564 to the Safety and
13 Worker's Compensation Fund from the unencumbered fund balance
14 to cover unanticipated Worker's Compensation Industrial
15 Insurance program costs.

16 SECTION 2. Ordinance 9729, Section 81, as amended, is
17 hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the
18 following:

19 SAFETY AND WORKER'S COMPENSATION - From the Safety and
20 Worker's Compensation Fund, there is hereby appropriated to:

21 Safety and Worker's Compensation \$469,564

22 Provided that:

23 The Executive submit to the Council, by January 31, 1992,
24 an explanation as to why the Safety and Worker's Compensation
25 budget was spent beyond its authorized expenditure level. The
26 explanation shall describe the Executive's current policies and
27 procedures for maintaining expenditures within authorized
28 budget limits, and explain how these policies and procedures
29 failed to prevent the overexpenditure of the Safety and

1 Worker's Compensation budget. Finally, the Executive shall
2 make recommendations as to how the financial policies and
3 procedures could be improved to prevent overexpenditures in the
4 future.

5 INTRODUCED AND READ for the first time this 11th day
6 of November, 1991.
