ORDINANCE NO. **10282**

AN ORDINANCE changing the composition of the Enumclaw Park and Recreation Service Area Board and amending Ordinance 9561, Section 1.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 9561, Section 1 is hereby amended to read as follows:

The council of King County hereby accepts the Enumclaw Park and Recreation Service area feasibility study as filed with the clerk of the council on July 12, 1990 and incorporated herein by reference (the "feasibility study") and the recommendations therein. The council makes the following findings:

A. The objectives of the proposed park and recreation service area are consistent with and fit within the applicable King County park plans and policies as required by RCW Chapter 36.68.400.

B. The exact boundaries of the proposed service area are those contained in Exhibit A hereto, incorporated herein by reference.

C. The improvements and services to be financed by the service area include construction of a senior citizen center community center, and other recreational facilities for the purpose of providing activities to citizens who are primarily residents of the proposed park and recreation service area. Bond proceeds would be used to construct the facility and pay related costs for issuance of the bonds. The proposed center would be operated and managed by the City of Enumclaw pursuant to a management contract as described in the feasibility study. Maintenance, repairs, operations expenses and insurance of the center would be paid by the City of Enumclaw.

D. There shall be a five member governing board. Three representatives shall be appointed by the King County council,

1 one of whom will be a member of the King County council and
2 ((another will be an elected official of a special purpose
3 district)) the other two will be citizens residing within the
4 boundaries of the PRSA. Two members will be from the Enumclaw
5 City council. The terms of appointments will be specified in
6 an interlocal agreement pursuant to RCW 39.34.

7 E. The objectives of the proposed service are feasible.

8 F. The service area, if formed, shall be called the
9 Enumclaw Park and Recreation Service Area.

10 Based upon the above findings, the council finds and
11 declares that the best interests of the residents in the
12 proposed service area require the formation of the service area
13 to carry out the program of construction and maintenance of the
14 senior citizen center, community center, and other recreational
15 facilities as described in the feasibility study.
