ORDINANCE NO. **10290**

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AN ORDINANCE relating to paid parking in County owned parking facilities; and amending Ordinance 8753, Section 4, 5, and 7; Ordinance 3511, Section 5; and K.C.C. Sections 3.32.005, 3.32.040, 3.32.055, and 3.32.090.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 3511, Section 5, as amended, and K.C.C. Section 3.32.040 are hereby amended to read as follows:

Public Parking area. Parking space will be established for public parking to be used in conjunction with county business. Members of the public on county business shall be charged for all time parked. Religious service volunteers who work at the King County jail are exempt from the payment of parking fees. Other ((E))exceptions from parking fees can be made if they meet explicit criteria for exemptions established in accordance with Section 3.32.010 and monitored by the King County auditor.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 8753, Section 5, as amended, and K.C.C. Section 3.32.055 is hereby amended as follows:

Parking rates - parking stalls. Effective ((parking)) January 1, 1992 monthly rates for ((January 1, 1992)) parking stalls in the King County automotive center, adult detention center, courthouse, Yesler Building, ((and)) open surface parking lots, and bicycle lockers shall be as follows:

Covered Parking Reserved	Covered Parking Unreserved	Surface Lots
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a. Vehicle Parking

\$100.00	\$90.00	\$75.00
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b. Motorcycle Parking

\$ 10.00

c. Bicycle Lockers

\$ 5.00

2 For disabled county employees whose disabilities make it
3 difficult or impossible to use public transit, and who display
4 a disabled parking permit, the fee for covered parking shall be
5 50 percent of the normal rate. Employees with disabilities
6 shall receive first priority in the assignment of available
7 parking stalls.

8 (~~Second and Third shift employees who are authorized to~~
9 ~~use available unreserved parking stalls on a regular basis~~
10 ~~within any of the county owned parking facilities shall pay~~
11 ~~\$45.00 per month.~~)

12 All county employees who are not assigned the use of a
13 reserved parking stall, or who are not authorized the use of
14 available unreserved parking areas on a regular basis, but who
15 have been authorized to park in the garage after hours and
16 weekends shall pay \$10.00 per month.))

17 Authorized second and third shift parking and interim use
18 parking in the automotive center shall be limited to floors
19 four through seven.

20 The executive will notify 2nd and 3rd shift employees of
21 the availability of escort service. The Executive shall also
22 develop a program for providing free parking for volunteers
23 working in the downtown county government complex and for
24 people downtown on county-related business such as public
25 hearings. This program is to be presented to the Council by
26 May 15th and could be implemented as soon as Current Expense
27 revenues improve.

28 SECTION 3. Ordinance 8753, Section 7 and K.C.C. Section
29 3.32.090 are hereby amended to read as follows:

30 Parking fee revenues - disposition. All revenues derived
31 from parking fees shall be distributed as follows:

32 All parking revenues derived from the increase of parking
33 rates for covered and uncovered parking effective on or after
34 January 1, 1989 shall be reserved for the support of health and

1 human services activities and shall be deposited in the Health
2 and Human Services Set-aside Fund.

3 ((PROVIDED THAT:))

4 All revenue derived from elimination of free public
5 parking, ((and all revenue derived from second and third shift
6 unreserved parking by county employees and from occasional
7 after hours and weekend parking from county employees,)) shall
8 be deposited in the Current Expense fund.
