ORDINANCE NO. **10307**

2 AN ORDINANCE calling for separate
3 elections to be held to nominate and
4 elect persons to fill the various
5 elective offices prescribed by law for
6 the city of Burien, which will be a
7 noncharter code city.

8 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

9 SECTION 1. On March 10, 1992, a special election was held
10 pursuant to King County Ordinance No. 10236 on the question of
11 whether the area known as Burien should be incorporated as a
12 noncharter code city.

13 SECTION 2. On March 20, 1992, the King County canvassing
14 board certified the results of the March 10th special election
15 on the question of incorporation, certifying that the proposed
16 incorporation of the area known as Burien had been approved.

17 SECTION 3. Pursuant to RCW 35.02.078, the county council
18 hereby calls for the manager of the division of records and
19 elections to hold separate elections to nominate and elect
20 persons to fill the various elective offices prescribed by law
21 for the City of Burien, based on its population and the fact
22 that Burien will be a noncharter code city with a council-
23 manager form of government.

24 SECTION 4. The primary election to nominate candidates
25 for these elective positions shall be held at a special
26 election occurring on Tuesday, May 19, 1992, as required by RCW
27 29.13.020.

28 SECTION 5. Following the primary election on May 19, the
29 manager of records and elections shall conduct a special
30 election to fill these elective positions to be held on
31 September 15, 1992 pursuant to RCW 35.02.078-.090.

32 SECTION 6. Both elections shall be conducted by the
33 manager of records and elections in accordance with all

1 applicable laws and ordinances, including those related to the
2 filing and withdrawal of declarations of candidacy.
