

ORDINANCE NO.

**10352**

AN ORDINANCE relating to district court boundaries, amending Ordinance 3714, Sections 3 and 20, and K.C.C. 2.68.070 and 2.68.180 and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 3714, Section 3, as amended and K.C.C. 2.68.070 are hereby amended to read as follows:

King County District Court - Organization.

A. NAME AND BOUNDARIES OF THE COURT: There shall be a single district court with boundaries of all the area within the boundaries of King County which include to the centerline of Puget Sound and all of the current city of Bothell as a joint district court district established pursuant to RCW 3.38.060 and named the District Court of the State of Washington in and for the district of King County. These boundaries include the Canyon Park annexation to the City of Bothell effective April 30, 1992.

B. NUMBER OF JUDGES TO BE ELECTED: Twenty-five full time judges.

C. POPULATION: 1,413,900.

D. LOCATION OF CENTRAL OFFICE: King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington.

E. LOCATION OF OTHER COURTROOMS: There are ten court facilities within the unified district located as follows:

1. Aukeen, located within the City of Kent.
2. Bellevue.
3. Federal Way.
4. Issaquah.
5. Mercer Island.
6. Northeast, located within the City of Redmond.
7. Renton.
8. Seattle.

1           9. Shoreline, located within the Shoreline community  
2 planning area.

3           10. Southwest, located in the vicinity of Burien with  
4 additional facilities in the vicinity of Vashon business  
5 district.

6           F. LOCATION OF RECORDS: Administrative records shall be  
7 maintained at the central office or as designated by the  
8 presiding judge. Court records shall be located at the  
9 respective court facilities or as otherwise designated by the  
10 presiding judge.

11           G. DISTRICT COURT COMMISSIONERS TO BE AUTHORIZED: The  
12 number and location of district court commissioners shall be as  
13 currently authorized, together with such additional court  
14 commissioners as the district court may require.

15           H. DEPARTMENTS INTO WHICH THE DISTRICT COURT SHALL BE  
16 INITIALLY ORGANIZED, INCLUDING MUNICIPAL DEPARTMENTS: (Courts  
17 facilities to which assigned are indicated within parenthesis).  
18 Cities of Algona, Auburn, Kent (Aukeen); Bellevue, Clyde Hill,  
19 Hunts Point, Medina, Yarrow Point (Bellevue); Issaquah, North  
20 Bend, Snoqualmie (Issaquah); Mercer Island, (Mercer Island);  
21 Bothell, Carnation, Kirkland, Redmond, Skykomish (Northeast);  
22 and Normandy Park (Southwest).

23           SECTION 2. Ordinance 3714, Section 20, as amended and  
24 K.C.C. 2.68.180 are hereby amended to read as follows:

25           Northeast electoral district - Boundaries. The legal  
26 boundaries of the Northeast electoral district shall be:

27           All of the area within the following described line:

28           Beginning at the intersection of the north boundary of  
29 King County and the west boundary of 80th Avenue Northeast;  
30 thence southerly along said west boundary of 80th Avenue  
31 Northeast to its intersection with the south boundary of  
32 Northeast Bothell Way; thence northwesterly on Northeast  
33 Bothell Way to its intersection with the centerline of Swamp  
34 Creek; thence westerly following said Swamp Creek to its  
35 intersection with the centerline of the Sammamish River: thence

1 westerly along said centerline to its intersection with the  
2 centerline of Lake Washington; thence southerly along said  
3 centerline to its intersection with the north-west extension of  
4 the centerline of Yarrow Bay; thence southeasterly along said  
5 centerline to its intersection with the current western  
6 corporate city limits of the city of Kirkland; thence southerly  
7 along said western corporate limits to its intersection with  
8 the centerline of Lake Washington Boulevard; thence easterly  
9 along said centerline to its intersection with the south  
10 boundary of the current corporate city limits of Kirkland;  
11 thence easterly along said city limits to its intersection with  
12 the east corporate city limits of Kirkland; thence northerly  
13 along said corporate limits to its intersection with the north  
14 boundary of Northeast 40th Street; thence easterly along said  
15 north boundary to its intersection with the west boundary of  
16 132nd Avenue Northeast; thence northerly along said west  
17 boundary to its intersection with the south boundary of  
18 Northeast 60th Street; thence easterly along said south  
19 boundary to its intersection with the centerline of 148th  
20 Avenue Northeast; thence southerly along said centerline to its  
21 intersection with the westerly extension of the south boundary  
22 of the current Redmond corporate city limits; thence  
23 northeasterly along said corporate city limits to its  
24 intersection with north boundary of the current Bellevue  
25 corporate city limits; thence northeasterly along said  
26 corporate city limits to its intersection with the centerline  
27 of 172nd Avenue Northeast; thence southerly along said  
28 centerline to its intersection with the south boundary of the  
29 Redmond corporate city limits; thence easterly along said  
30 corporate city limits and its easterly extension to its  
31 intersection with the centerline of Lake Sammamish; thence  
32 southerly along said centerline to its intersection with the  
33 centerline of the Inglewood Hill Road and extension; thence  
34 southeasterly along said centerline to its intersection with  
35 the centerline of Northeast 8th Street; thence easterly along

1 said centerline to its intersection with the centerline of  
2 244th Avenue Northeast; thence northerly along said centerline  
3 to its intersection with the south boundary of the Redmond-Fall  
4 City Road; thence southeasterly along said south boundary to  
5 its intersection with the centerline of 308th Avenue Southeast;  
6 thence northerly along said centerline to its intersection with  
7 the centerline of Southeast 24th Street; thence easterly along  
8 said centerline to its intersection with the centerline of  
9 312th Avenue Southeast; thence northerly along said centerline  
10 to its intersection with the centerline of the West Snoqualmie  
11 River Road; thence northwesterly along said centerline to its  
12 intersection with the centerline of Patterson Creek; thence  
13 northerly along said centerline to its intersection with the  
14 centerline of the Snoqualmie River; thence northerly along said  
15 centerline to its intersection with the centerline of Griffin  
16 Creek; thence easterly along said centerline to its  
17 intersection with the west boundary of Section 30 Township 25  
18 N, Range 8 E.W.M.; thence southerly along said west boundary to  
19 its intersection with the South boundary of Section 30,  
20 Township 25; Range 8; thence easterly along south boundaries of  
21 Section 30, 29, 28, 27, Township 25, Range 8, to its  
22 intersection with the east boundary of Section 27, Township 25,  
23 Range 8; thence northerly along said boundary of Sections 27,  
24 22, 15, 10, 3, Township 25, Range 8, to its intersection with  
25 south boundary of Section 35, Township 26, Range 8; thence  
26 easterly along the south boundaries of Section 35 and 36,  
27 Township 26 N, Range 8 E.W.M., and Sections 31, 32, 33, 34, 35  
28 and 36, Township 26 N, Range 9 E.W.M. to its intersection with  
29 the east boundary of Range 9; thence south long said east  
30 boundary to its intersection with the centerline of the middle  
31 fork of the Snoqualmie River; thence easterly along said  
32 centerline to its intersection with the east boundary of King  
33 County; thence northerly along said east boundary to its  
34 intersection with the north boundary of King County; thence  
35 westerly along said north boundary to its intersection with the

1 city of Bothell corporate limits; thence north then following  
2 said Bothell corporate limits to its intersection with the west  
3 boundary of 80th Avenue Northeast, and the true point of  
4 beginning. These boundaries include the Canyon Park annexation  
5 to the City of Bothell effective April 30, 1992.

6 SECTION 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take  
7 effect on April 30, 1992.

8 SECTION 4. The county council finds as a fact and  
9 declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is  
10 necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace,  
11 health or safety or for the support of county government and  
12 its existing public institutions.
