

ORDINANCE NO. **10363**

AN ORDINANCE relating to the establishment of 138th Avenue Northeast from Northeast 171st Street to Northeast 177th Street.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: The director of the department of public works has made an examination of 138th Avenue Northeast from Northeast 171st Street to Northeast 177th Street along a course and description set forth below and has made favorable report upon same, as required by R.C.W. 36.81.050.

SECTION 2: 138th Avenue Northeast shall be established at not less than seventy two feet in width, having thirty six feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:

Beginning at a point on the centerline of Northeast 171st Street, said point being S 23°56'21" W a distance of 1391.07 feet from the center of section 10, township 26 north, range 5 east, W.M.; thence N 35°55'08" W a distance of 2.44 feet; thence along an arc of a curve to the right having a radius of 450.00 feet, a distance of 284.62 feet; thence N 0°19'12" E a distance of 322.23 feet; thence along an arc of a curve to the right having a radius of 450.00 feet, a distance of 102.10 feet; thence N 13°19'12" E, a distance of 109.60 feet; thence along an arc of a curve to the left having a radius of 450 feet, a distance of 105.44 feet; thence N 0°06'16" W a distance of 378.98 feet; thence N 13°00'00" E a distance of 373.51 feet; thence along an arc of a curve to the left having a radius of 450.00 feet, a distance of 103.65 feet; thence N 0°11'50" W a distance of 232.12 feet to the terminus on the centerline of Northeast 177th Street, said terminus being N 35°30'23" W a distance of 871.44 feet from said center of section 10. 2014.69 feet = 0.382 miles m/l

SECTION 3: King County council finds that the establishment of 138th Avenue Northeast, along the course and description set forth, is a public necessity.

SECTION 4: Said road establishment, unless it is renewed by council action, shall lapse at the close of business on May 18, 1994.

SECTION 5: The director of public works, or his designee, shall report to the King County council no later than December 31, 1993 on the following items:

- A. The relationship of the proposed downtown Woodinville road grid to the proposed Northshore Community Plan;
- B. The effect of the current Woodinville road grid to the business uses of affected business establishments in the downtown Woodinville area;

1 C. Alternative road establishments in the downtown Woodinville road grid consistent with the
2 proposed traffic circulation pattern contained in the proposed Northshore Community Plan;

3 D. The effects of bypass roads in the Woodinville grid area on traffic circulation patterns, and on
4 the need to construct additional county roads.

5 SECTION 6: In the event that the community of Woodinville incorporates prior to the completion of
6 this study, the director of the department of public works shall terminate this study and shall furnish to the
7 city of Woodinville any and all materials, statistical data, information and conclusions generated as a
8 result of this study.
