

ORDINANCE NO. **10393**

2 AN ORDINANCE relating to drug-free zones;
3 approving a map of the location and
4 boundaries of areas in the Catholic
5 Archdiocese within which unlawful
6 transactions in controlled substances are
7 subject to enhanced penalties pursuant to
8 RCW 69.50.435.

9 PREAMBLE:

10 Ordinance 10154 established a procedure for the
11 production or reproduction of maps depicting the
12 location and boundaries of parks, schools and areas
13 within one thousand feet of schools, within which
14 unlawful transactions in controlled substances are
15 subject to enhanced penalties as imposed pursuant to
16 RCW 69.50.435. Upon the request of the governing
17 body of the Catholic Archdiocese, King County has
18 prepared a map depicting such boundaries. It is in
19 the public interest to provide notice of the location
20 of such areas and to expedite prosecution,
21 conviction, and enhanced penalties for cases of
22 unlawful transactions in controlled substances in
23 such locations.

24 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

25 SECTION 1. The boundaries of drug-free zones surrounding
26 the following schools as listed in Exhibits A - C located in
27 the Catholic Archdiocese are hereby adopted for: A. John F.
28 Kennedy Memorial High School; B. St. Francis of Assisi
29 Elementary School; and C. St. Bernadette Elementary School.

30 The maps produced by the county engineer of the location
31 and boundaries of the drug-free zones surrounding these schools

1 within the Catholic Archdiocese, as supported by Archdiocese
2 endorsement, have been filed with the clerk of the Council.


