ORDINANCE NO. **10413**

AN ORDINANCE approving the Cedar River Water and Sewer District 1991 Comprehensive Water System Plan.

PREAMBLE:

WAC 248-56-710 requires individual water districts to update their plans to be consistent with the relevant Coordinated Water System Plan (CWSP). The East King County CWSP covers the Cedar River Water and Sewer District.

On February 6, 1991 the Cedar River Water and Sewer District made a determination of non-significance regarding its 1991 comprehensive water system plan.

On March 6, 1991 the Board of Commissioners of the Cedar River Water and Sewer District passed Resolution No. 2838 adopting the plan.

On February 12, 1992 the King County Utilities Technical Review Committee met to consider the plan and finding it consistent with K.C.C. 13.24, Ordinance No. 10095, and the East King County Coordinated Water System Plan, recommended approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Cedar River Water and Sewer District 1991 comprehensive water system plan is hereby approved with no conditions.
