

ORDINANCE NO. **10479**

AN ORDINANCE approving the LSA boundary adjustment and concurring with the recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, amending King County Zoning Resolution No. 25789, as amended, by reclassifying certain property upon the application of HAROLD AND ESTELLE JOHNSON, designated Building and Land Development File No. L91RZ001.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. This ordinance adopts and incorporates the findings and conclusions of the June 24, 1992 report of the zoning and subdivision examiner, filed with the clerk of the council on July 9, 1992, on the application of Harold and Estelle Johnson to reclassify certain property described in building and land development file no. L91RZ001.

SECTION 2. The recommendation of the zoning and subdivision examiner to approve the LSA boundary adjustment and to reclassify the subject property from SC-P (potential SR-P) to SR-P, subject to conditions (modified), is hereby adopted by the council of King County. Those conditions, if any, which must be satisfied before this ordinance becomes effective must be satisfied within one year of council approval, or all authority

1 granted by this ordinance shall expire and this ordinance shall
2 be of no further force or effect. (if none, the effective date
3 shall be ten days after enactment.) Upon this ordinance
4 becoming effective, the building and land development division
5 shall amend the official zoning maps of King County to reflect
6 this action.
