ORDINANCE NO. **10510**

AN ORDINANCE relating to drug-free zones;
approving a map of the location and boundary of
an area surrounding Eastside Catholic High
School within which unlawful transactions in
controlled substances are subject to enhanced
penalties pursuant to RCW 69.50.435.

PREAMBLE:

Ordinance 10154 established a procedure for the
production or reproduction of maps depicting the location
and boundaries of parks, schools and areas within one
thousand feet of schools, within which unlawful
transactions in controlled substances are subject to
enhanced penalties as imposed pursuant to RCW 69.50.435.
Upon request of the governing body of Eastside Catholic
High School, King County has prepared a map depicting
such boundary. It is in the public interest to provide
notice of the location of such areas and to expedite
prosecution, conviction, and enhanced penalties for cases
of unlawful transactions in controlled substances in such
locations.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: The boundary of a drug-free zone surrounding
Eastside Catholic High School as identified in Exhibit A is
hereby adopted.
