AN ORDINANCE making an additional appropriation of \$257,254 to the Public Works ER&R from the unencumbered fund balance for the installation of a compressed natural gas (CNG) fueling facility at the Renton Consolidated Office and Repair Facility, and amending Ordinance No. 10182, Section 90, as amended, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$257,254 to the Public Works ER&R fund from the unencumbered fund balance for the installation of a compressed natural gas (CNG) fueling facility at the Renton Consolidated Office and Repair Facility.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 10182, Section 90, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:
