ORDINANCE NO. **10596**

AN ORDINANCE approving the Beulah Park Water System Comprehensive Plan.

PREAMBLE:

K.C.C. 13.24 requires approval of comprehensive plans for water purveyors as a prerequisite to the granting of right-of-way franchises and approval of right-of-way construction permits.

The Beulah Park Water System Comprehensive Plan was approved by vote of the board of directors of the Beulah Park Water System on August 16, 1992.

On July 22, 1992 the King County Utilities Technical Review Committee met to consider the plan and finding it consistent with K.C.C. 13.24 recommended approval.

The Beulah Park Water System is categorically exempt from threshold determination and environmental impact statement requirements in accordance with the State Environmental Policy Act (Ch. 197-11-800 WAC).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Beulah Park Water System Comprehensive Plan, attached as Exhibit A, is hereby approved with no conditions.
