AN ORDINANCE agreeing to a revision of the corporate boundary of the City of Redmond to include a portion of NE 95th Street pursuant to RCW 35.21.790.

PREAMBLE:

The King County council hereby finds:

- 1. The City of Redmond desires to provide water service to serve the Jehovah Witness Church on NE 95th Street, but has not complied with the comprehensive plan and franchise requirements necessary for the placement of utilities in county rights-of-way.
- 2. RCW 35.21.790 permits the governing bodies of counties and cities to revise by agreement any part of the corporate boundary of a city which coincides with the edge of a public street by substituting a right-of-way line of the same street so as to fully include that street segment in the corporate limits of the city.
- 3. Revision of the corporate boundary to include a portion of NE 95th Street as identified in Section 1 of this ordinance within Redmond would allow Redmond to install water and sewer lines under the city's regulations governing such installation, and would remove the matter from the county's jurisdiction.
- 4. RCW 35.21.790 provides that such boundary revision becomes effective when approved by city ordinance and by county ordinance.
- 5. The City of Redmond agrees to accept this portion of NE 95th Street in its current existing condition.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to RCW 35.21.790 the corporate boundary of the City of Redmond is hereby revised to include the following legally described right-of-way:

That portion of the Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 6, Township 25 North, Range 6 East, W.M.; and of the Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 6, Township 25 North, Range 6 East, W.M.; Situate in the City of Redmond, County of King, State of Washington described as follows:

All of NE 95th (also known as Conrad Olsen RD No. 1427, 1 Surv No 1730a Est 1-27-1930, Co Comm. Vol330-212) lying between 2 3 the Easterly line of that area described in Redmond Ordinance 1631 as annexed to said City and ending at the northerly 4 extension of the east line of the west half of southwest 5 quarter of northeast quarter Section 6, Township 25, North 6 7 Range 6 East, W.M.
