ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE approving the Heights Water System Comprehensive Plan.

PREAMBLE:
K.C.C. 13.24 requires approval of comprehensive plans for water purveyors as a prerequisite to the granting of right-of-way franchises and approval of right-of-way construction permits.

The Heights Water System Comprehensive Plan was approved by vote of the board of directors of the Heights Water District on September 1, 1992.

On August 19, 1992 the King County Utilities Technical Review Committee met to consider the plan and finding it consistent with K.C.C. 13.24 recommended approval.

The Heights Water District is categorically exempt from threshold determination and environmental impact statement requirements in accordance with the State Environmental Policy Act (Ch. 197-11-800 WAC).


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:
