2 AN ORDINANCE relating to drug-free zones;
3 approving a map of the location and boundaries
4 of areas in the Snoqualmie Valley School
5 District No. 410 within which unlawful
6 transactions in controlled substances are
7 subject to enhanced penalties pursuant to RCW
8 69.50.435, and adding a new section to K.C.C.
9 12.82.

7 PREAMBLE:

8 K.C.C. 12.82 establishes a procedure for the production
9 or reproduction of maps depicting the location and
10 boundaries of parks, schools and areas within one
11 thousand feet of schools, within which unlawful
12 transactions in controlled substances are subject to
13 enhanced penalties as imposed pursuant to RCW 69.50.435.
14 Upon request of the governing body of the Snoqualmie
15 Valley School District No. 410, King County has prepared
16 a map depicting such boundaries. It is in the public
17 interest to provide notice of the location of such areas
18 and to expedite prosecution, conviction, and enhanced
19 penalties for cases of unlawful transactions in
20 controlled substances in such locations.

15 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

16 SECTION 1: The boundaries of drug-free zones surrounding the
17 following schools as listed in Exhibits "A" thru "F" located
18 within the Snoqualmie Valley School District No. 410 are hereby
19 adopted:

- 20 A. Fall City Elementary School
21 B. North Bend Elementary School
22 C. Opstad Elementary School
23 D. Chief Kanim Middle School
24 E. Snoqualmie Elementary, Snoqualmie Middle School and
25 Mt. Si Athletic Fields
26 F. Mt. Si Senior High School
