AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation of \$560,980 to the Department of Adult Detention from the Current Expense Fund; \$69,234 to the Department of Adult Detention/Criminal Justice from the Criminal Justice Fund; and a disappropriation of \$560,980 from Special Programs Executive Contingency; and amending Ordinance No. 10182, Sections 36, 42, and 103, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$560,980 to the Department of Adult Detention from the Current Expense Fund, \$69,234 from the Criminal Justice Fund balance, and a disappropriation of \$560,980 from Special Programs, Executive Contingency for the 1992 fiscal year due to higher than projected overtime expenditures related to inmate population increases and Hammer staffing restrictions.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 10182, Section 36, as amended is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

SPECIAL PROGRAMS, EXECUTIVE CONTINGENCY - From the Current Expense Fund there is hereby disappropriated from:  
Special Programs, Executive Contingency (\$ 560,980)

SECTION 3. Ordinance 10182, Section 42, as amended is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

ADULT DETENTION - From the Current Expense Fund there is hereby appropriated to:  
Adult Detention \$ 560,980

SECTION 4. Ordinance 10182, Section 103, as amended is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

CRIMINAL JUSTICE FUND - From the Criminal Justice Fund there is hereby appropriated to:  
Adult Detention/Criminal Justice \$ 69,234

2 By May 15, 1993, the Executive shall submit for Council  
3 review and approval a plan to manage overtime which is  
4 consistent with audit recommendations.


