

ORDINANCE NO. **10765**

AN ORDINANCE approving the City of  
Redmond Water System Plan.

PREAMBLE:

K.C.C. 13.24 requires approval of comprehensive plans for water purveyors as a prerequisite to the granting of right-of-way franchises and approval of right-of-way construction permits.

On May 27, 1992, the King County Utilities Technical Review Committee met to consider the plan and finding it consistent with K.C.C. 13.24 recommended approval.

The City of Redmond Water System Plan was approved by vote of the Redmond City Council on May 4, 1992.

The City of Redmond issued a determination of nonsignificance in accordance with the State Environmental Policy Act in May 1992.

On May 29, 1990 the King County Council approved Ordinance No. 9462 ratifying the Coordinated Water System Plan for the East King County Critical Water Supply Service Area which recommends to the Washington State Department of Health that the unresolved service area between City of Redmond and Union Hill Water Association be assigned to the City of Redmond.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The City of Redmond Water System Plan, attached as Exhibit A, the Water System Plan Appendices attached as Exhibit B, and the Water Conservation Plan attached as Exhibit C are hereby approved with the following conditions:

A. Exhibit A Figure I-1 Study Area Map and Figure I-2 Adjacent Water Purveyors Map: The City of Redmond is required to revise the maps as follows:

1. Rename Potential Future Service Area Boundary as City of Redmond Sphere of Influence;
  2. Rename Authorized Study Area as CWSP Service Area;
- and
3. Outline the service area in question between the City of Redmond and Union Hill Water Association.

B. The State of Washington Department of Health resolves the service area dispute between the City of Redmond and Union Hill by assigning the area to the City of Redmond. If the Department of Health rules otherwise, the City of Redmond is

1 required to transmit to the council new service area boundaries  
2 and policies in the form of a water system plan amendment  
3 within six months of the ruling.
