ORDINANCE NO. **10774**

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$166,000 to the Parks Division, from Special Programs - Executive Contingency, and other revenues, for the Summer Beach Lifeguard Program, and amending Ordinance 10641, Sections 19 and 37, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted a supplemental appropriation of \$166,000 to the parks division from Special Programs - Executive Contingency, and other revenues, for the Summer Beach Lifeguard Program.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 10641, Section 19, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:
