ORDINANCE NO. **10820**

AN ORDINANCE approving and adopting the Collective Bargaining Agreement negotiated by and between King County and the Washington State Council of City and County Employees, AFSCME, Local 21; establishing the effective date of said Agreement; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Collective Bargaining Agreement negotiated between King County and the Washington State Council of City and County Employees, AFSCME, Local 21, representing employees in the Seattle-King County department of public health and attached hereto is hereby approved and adopted and by this reference made a part hereof, conditioned upon ratification by the Seattle City Council.

SECTION 2. Terms and conditions of said agreement shall be effective from January 1, 1993, through and including December 31, 1995.

SECTION 3. The county council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.
