ORDINANCE NO. **10959**

AN ORDINANCE granting an extension of preliminary approval for the PLAT of LICORICE FERN II (BALD File No. 87-475); and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Findings. The council finds that:

A. The applicant has timely filed a written request for an extension of twelve months for preliminary plat approval.

B. The applicant has complied with and met the provisions of the King County Code and state law.

C. The applicant has acted in good faith and made substantial progress in complying with the conditions of preliminary approval.

D. It would be inequitable to require the applicant to reapply.

SECTION 2. Preliminary approval for the plat of LICORICE FERN II (BALD File No. 87-475) is granted an extension to expire on July 30, 1994.

SECTION 3. The county council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.
