

ORDINANCE NO. **11006**

AN ORDINANCE relating to drug-free zones; approving maps of the location and boundaries of areas in the Shoreline School District within which unlawful transactions in controlled substances are subject to enhanced penalties pursuant to RCW 69.50.435, and adding a new section to K.C.C. 12.82.

PREAMBLE:

K.C.C. 12.82 establishes a procedure for the production or reproduction of maps depicting the location and boundaries of parks, schools and areas within one thousand feet of schools, within which unlawful transactions in controlled substances are subject to enhanced penalties as imposed pursuant to RCW 69.50.435. Upon request of the governing body of the Shoreline School District, King County has prepared maps depicting such boundaries. It is in the public interest to provide notice of the location of such areas and to expedite prosecution, conviction, and enhanced penalties for cases of unlawful transactions in controlled substances in such locations.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: The boundaries of drug-free zones surrounding the following schools as listed in Exhibits "A" through "Q" located within the Shoreline School District are hereby adopted:

- A. Briarcrest Elementary School and Shorecrest High School.
- B. Brookside Elementary School.
- C. Cedarbrook Elementary School.
- D. Echo Lake Elementary School.
- E. Highland Terrace Elementary School.
- F. Lake Forest Park Elementary School.
- G. Meridian Park Elementary School.
- H. North City Elementary School.
- I. Parkwood Elementary School.
- J. Ridgcrest Elementary School.
- K. Sunset Elementary School.
- L. Syre Elementary School.
- M. Einstein Middle School.




