ORDINANCE NO. **11022**

AN ORDINANCE approving the City of Kent Water System Plan.

PREAMBLE:

K.C.C. 13.24 requires approval of comprehensive plans for water purveyors as a prerequisite to the granting of right-of-way franchises and approval of right-of-way construction permits.

The City of Kent Water System Plan was approved by vote of the Kent City Council on January 2, 1991 and the conservation element was approved on June 1, 1993.

On February 12, 1992 the King County Utilities Technical Review Committee met to consider the plan and on July 14, 1993 met to consider the conservation element and, finding it consistent with K.C.C. 13.24, recommended approval.

The City of Kent issued a determination of nonsignificance in accordance with the State Environmental Policy Act in September 1988.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:


