

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the vacation of a portion of 221st Place Southeast and refunding over-payment of compensation - V-2157; Petitioner: David Kline

STATEMENT OF ACTS

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of that portion of 221st Place Southeast hereinafter described.
- 2. The department of public works has notified the various utilities serving the area and has been advised that easements are not required.
- 3. The land use section of the department of development and environmental services has studied the proposed road vacation and finds that it would not conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 4. The department of public works found no evidence that the vacation area has ever been open as a road. A search of the records indicates no public funds have been expended for its acquisition, improvement or maintenance. The department of public works considers the subject right of way useless as part of the county road system and believes the public would benefit by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.
- 5. The King County Road Standards require a cul de sac with a minimum radius of forty feet for a minor access street (residential) in an urban area. The proposed cul de sac would lie on a portion of the petitioner's property within Block 2 of the unrecorded plat of Pinecrest. Therefore, as a requirement of the road vacation the petitioner will deed to King County, for road purposes, that portion of said Block 2 lying within the proposed cul de sac.
- 6. The right of way is classified "C Class" and in accordance with King County Code 14.40.020, the compensation due King County is based on fifty percent of the appraised value of the adjoining lands which may be determined from records of the department of assessments. This amount is \$15,653.90. King County is in receipt of \$15,928.58 from the petitioners.
- 7. Petitioner will provide exchange right of way for a portion of the above mentioned cul de sac. The compensation is adjusted for exchange right of way in the amount of \$452.92. The adjusted amount of compensation due King County for the road vacation is \$15,200.98. The amount was determined by multiplying the vacation area by fifty percent of the assessed value per square foot of the adjacent property, and deducting the exchange value of right of way conveyed by the petitioner to King County. The difference between the amount deposited by the petitioner and the adjusted compensation due, \$727.60, will be refunded to petitioner upon completion of these proceedings.

Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the office of the zoning and subdivision examiner on the 28th day of September, 1993.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 2: The petitioner's over-payment of the net compensation due for this vacation of right of way shall be refunded to the petitioner.

Beginning at a point on the centerline of said 221st Place SE, said point being the True Point of Beginning of the centerline as described in said instrument recorded under Recording Number 2883399; thence along said centerline the following courses and distances; thence N71°12'14"E 41.06 feet; thence N49°56'14"E 161.40 feet to a point of curve; thence easterly on said curve to the right having a radius of 59.78 feet, through a central angle of 38°44'10", an arc distance of 40.42 feet to a point hereinafter called "Point A"; thence N01°19'36"W 33.75 feet to the southeast corner of a tract of land described in an instrument recorded under Recording Number 2832640, said tract being known as Lot 52, Block 1, Pinecrest, according to the unrecorded plat thereof and the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING of this line; thence S01°19'36"E 33.75 feet to the aforementioned "Point A" and a point on a curve, the center which bears S53°51'29"E 42.00 feet; thence southerly along said curve to the left, through a central angle of $45^{\circ}10'02''$, an arc distance of 33.11 feet to the southerly margin of said 221st Place SE and the terminus of this line.
