ORDINANCE NO. **11142**

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AN ORDINANCE relating to park and recreation facilities fees, and amending Ordinance No. 5225, Section 2(A), (B), as amended, Ordinance No. 6027, Sections 2 and 3, Ordinance 9227, Section 1(Part), as amended and K.C.C. 7.08.020, .025, .030 and 040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 5225, Section 2(A), as amended, and K.C.C. 7.08.020 are amended to read as follows:

Swimming pool facilities (except Weyerhaeuser King County Aquatics Center). Swimming pool facilities fees shall be:

A. Swimming pool fees (fees include sales tax)

- Seventy-five Cent Swims:... 0.75 per person per session
