1 ORDINANCE NO.

11204

2 AN ORDINANCE relating to levying the
3 property taxes of King County for the year
4 of 1994 and amending Ordinance 11192,
5 Section 2, and declaring an emergency.

6 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

7 SECTION 1. Ordinance 11192, Section 2, is amended to read
8 as follows: The Council of King County, Washington, finds that
9 the levies necessary to fund estimated expenditures for the
10 year 1994, less the total of estimated revenues from sources
11 other than taxation, including available surplus and such
12 expenditures as are to be met from bond warrant issues, be and
13 the same are hereby fixed as follows:
