AN ORDINANCE relating to the assumption by King County of the rights, powers, functions, and obligations of the former Municipality of Metropolitan Seattle (Metro); readopting and ratifying Ordinance Nos. 11032, 11033 and 11034 related to the creation and operation of the Department of Metropolitan Services; and prescribing penalties.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance Nos. 11032, 11033 and 11034

establishing the Department of Metropolitan Services and its various divisions effective 1 January 1994, creating a new title in the King County Code, establishing funds for the department, and establishing and prescribing various policies, rules, regulations and penalties related to the operation of the department are each hereby readopted and ratified.
