ORDINANCE NO. **11276**

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of Salmon Creek Elementary School and nearby single-family homes, an area formally known as 93-1, to King County Water District 20.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of Salmon Creek Elementary School and nearby single-family homes, formally known as 93-1, to King County Water District 20 was filed with the county council effective February 28, 1994.

2. King County Water District 20 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution No. 533 concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. King County Water District 20 filed a Declaration of Non-Significance Impact dated January 10, 1994, on the proposed annexation.

4. The county council held a public hearing on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of March, 1994 and has considered the criteria set forth in R.C.W. 57.02.040.

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District 20 of Salmon Creek Elementary School and nearby single-family homes, formally known as 93-1, and described in Section 4 herein is approved. This proposed annexation is consistent with R.C.W. 57.02.040.

SECTION 2. King County Water District 20 is the appropriate entity to serve the area proposed to be annexed.

SECTION 3. Completion of this annexation does not constitute county approval or disapproval of any other permits, certifications, or actions necessary to provide service to this annexation area.

SECTION 4. The area known as 93-1 is described as follows:

All that portion of the West 1/2 of the West 1/2 of the East 1/2 of Section 7, Township 23 North, Range 4 East, W.M., in King County, Washington;

Beginning at the NE corner of the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of said Section 7;

Thence South along the East line of said SW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 and along the East line of the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of said Section 7, to the South line thereof;

Thence West along said South line of the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 to its intersection with the Southerly extension of the East line of the Plat of Goetzman, recorded in Volume 60 of Plats, page 58, Records of King County Washington;

1 Thence North 1° 27' 04" East along said Southerly  
2 extension and East line of said Plat of Goetzman in the North  
3 line of said plat;

4 Thence South 89° 54' 54.2" East along said North line, 1.09  
5 feet, to the West line of the Plat of Hidden Meadow, recorded  
6 in Volume 72 of Plats, Page 70, Records of King County,  
7 Washington

8 Thence North along said West line and its Northerly  
9 extension, 350.04 feet, more or less, to Northern margin of  
10 Southwest 120th Street;

12 Thence East along said Northern margin, to its intersection  
13 with the West line of the East 323.5 feet of the Southwest 1/4  
14 of the Southwest 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of said Section 7;

15 Thence North along said West line to the North line  
16 thereof;

17 Thence East along said North line to the TRUE POINT OF  
18 BEGINNING.
