

ORDINANCE NO. **11296**

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$257,892 to fund the removal and replacement of a worn out watermain near the McAleer Creek Bypass Pipeline Project (OA1455); and amending Ordinance 11130, Section 117, Attachment 2, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$257,892 to the McAleer Bypass Pipeline, Capital Improvement Project OA1455 in the Surface Water Management CIP Fund 329-2 from reimbursement from the City of Seattle Drainage and Wastewater Utility and the Shoreline Water District.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 11130, Section 117, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

From the several capital improvements project funds there are hereby appropriated and authorized to be disbursed the following amounts for the specific projects identified in Attachment No. 2 of this ordinance.
