ORDINANCE NO. **11378**

AN ORDINANCE making a supplemental appropriation of \$57,333 to Parks, Planning and Resource Administration from the undesignated fund balance of the Current Expense Fund, and amending Ordinance 11130, Section 17, as amended, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted a supplemental appropriation of \$172,000 to parks, planning and resource administration from the undesignated fund balance of the Current Expense Fund.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 11130, Section 17, as amended is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

PARKS, PLANNING AND RESOURCES ADMINISTRATION - From the Current Expense Fund, there is hereby appropriated to:

Parks, Planning and Resource Administration: \$57,333

The maximum number of additional FTEs for Parks, Planning and Resource Administration shall be: 0.75

The unexpended and unencumbered balance of the Parks, Planning and Resource Administration appropriation shall lapse on August 31, 1994.
