AN ORDINANCE designating the specified section of State Highway 18 in the Maple Valley area as an engine compression brake control area, requesting the Washington State Department of Transportation to post signs, and adding a new section to K.C.C. 46.12.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is added to K.C.C. 46.12 a new section to read as follows: State Highway 18 engine compression brake control area.

The following area is hereby designated as an engine compression brake control area pursuant to K.C.C. 46.12.010:

State Highway 18 from milepost 14.65 (208 Avenue Southeast) to milepost 17.40 (236 Avenue Southeast).

SECTION 2. The Washington State Department of Transportation is hereby requested to post appropriate signs.
