ORDINANCE NO.

7 AN ORDINANCE relating to levying the
8 property taxes of King County for the
9 year of 1994 and amending Ordinance 11204;
10 Section 2 as amended, and declaring an emergency.

11 PREAMBLE:

14 The 1994 property tax levy ordinance for the Rural
15 Library District omitted property in the Town of Clyde
16 Hill and the City of Carnation. The voters of these
17 jurisdictions chose in 1992 to annex to the Rural Library
18 District effective January 1, 1994. The Rural Library
19 District levy will hereby be amended to include the
20 amounts attributable to those residents and corrected
21 property tax statements will be mailed to them.

23 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

25 SECTION 1. Ordinance 11192, Section 2, as amended, is
26 amended to read as follows: The Council of King County,
27 Washington, finds that the levies necessary to fund estimated
28 expenditures for the year 1994, less the total of estimated
29 revenues from sources other than taxation, including available
30 surplus and such expenditures as are to be met from bond
31 warrant issues, be and the same are hereby fixed as follows:

3 indicated above and to prepare and mail corrected tax
4 statements to the affected taxpayers.

5 SECTION 3. The county finds as a fact and declares that an
6 emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the
7 immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for
8 the support of county government and its existing public
9 institutions.
