ORDINANCE NO. **11440**

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$75,000 to the Parks Recreation and Open Space Development Fund No. 316 for Richmond Beach Parking lot rehabilitation from unappropriated Real Estate Excise Tax (REET) #2 fund balance, and amending Ordinance 11130, Sections 87 and 117, and attachment 2, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$75,000 to the Parks Recreation and Open Space Development Fund No. 316 for Richmond Beach Parking Lot Rehabilitation from unappropriated Real Estate Excise Tax (REET) #2 fund.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 11130, Section 87, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

REAL ESTATE EXCISE TAX (REET) #2 - From the Real Estate Excise Tax #2 Fund is hereby appropriated to:

Real Estate Excise Tax (REET) #2 \$75,000

SECTION 3. Ordinance 11130, Section 117, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

From the several capital improvement project funds there are hereby approved and authorized to be disbursed the following amounts for the specific projects in Attachment No. 2 of this ordinance.
