ORDINANCE NO. **11507**

AN ORDINANCE relating to the minimum wages to be paid by King County to its employees and by businesses contracting with King County to provide goods or service, making exceptions, and amending Ordinance 8636 and K.C.C. 3.15.100.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 8636 and K.C.C. 3.15.100 are hereby amended as follows:

A. No employee of King County working full-time, part-time or temporary shall be paid at any rate of less than (~~(\$3.85 per hour until January 1, 1990 nor less than \$4.25 after that date)~~) \$4.25 per hour after January 1, 1990.

B. No contractor or subcontractor doing business with King County or furnishing workers or services in connection thereof shall pay any employee performing any work for such business with King County less than (~~(\$3.85 per hour up to January 1, 1990, and)~~) \$4.25 per hour ((thereafter)) after January 1, 1990.

C. The terms of this ordinance are not applicable to volunteer or quasi volunteer EMS workers, or to volunteer election workers provided by non-profit agencies.

INTRODUCED AND READ for the first time this 6<sup>th</sup> day of September, 1994.

PASSED by a vote of 12 to 0 this 3<sup>rd</sup> day of October, 1994.
