

ORDINANCE NO. **11656**

AN ORDINANCE authorizing a change in the scope of the 1989 open space bond city of Kent Lake Fenwick Trail Project to eliminate the trail south of the Lake, provide for acquisition and development of a soft surface trail over the remainder of the route and include a paved parking area north of the Lake.

PREAMBLE:

1. The Lake Fenwick Trail Project calls for the acquisition and development of a 12-foot wide trail extending to 51st Place South from the Green River.
2. Neighbors to the project strongly oppose the trail section south of the lake even though the primary purpose of this section of the trail was to provide these neighbors access to the lake and Green River.
3. The topography of the trail is too steep for paving as called for in the project scope but the project purposes would be substantially achieved with a soft surface trail.
4. The King County Open Space Citizen Oversight Committee adopted a resolution recommending elimination of the south portion of the trail and endorses the concept of a paved parking area north of the lake.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is approved and adopted a change in the scope of the 1989 open space bond city of Kent Lake Fenwick Trail Project to eliminate the trail south of the Lake, to provide for acquisition and development of a soft surface trail over the remainder of this route and to include a paved parking
