

ORDINANCE NO. **11657**

AN ORDINANCE relating to Solid Waste Division Environmental Reserve and Landfill Reserve Funds; amending Ordinance 10056, Section 1, and Ordinance 6177, Section 4, as amended; and K.C.C. 4.08.160 and K.C.C. 10.12.025.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 10056, Section 1, and K.C.C. 4.08.160

are amended to read as follows:

Solid Waste Environmental Reserve Fund. There is hereby created the Solid Waste Environmental Reserve Fund. The Solid Waste Environmental Reserve Fund shall be classified as a Capital Improvement Fund. The Solid Waste Environmental Reserve Fund shall be a first tier fund as described in Chapter 4.10.010 of the King County Code. The solid waste division (~~department of public works~~) shall be the fund manager. Uses of the Solid Waste Environmental Reserve Fund monies shall be limited to the following:

1. ~~((#))~~ Remediation costs related to active and closed solid waste handling facilities which the King County solid waste division owns or has custodial responsibility for;

2. Operations and maintenance costs related to closed solid waste handling facilities which the King County solid waste division owns or has custodial responsibility for, and which are not supported by reserves in the Landfill Post-Closure Maintenance Fund; and ~~((#))~~

3. ~~((e))~~ Costs related to inverse condemnation claims that result from King County solid waste activities.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 6177, Section 4, as amended, and K.C.C. 10.12.025 are amended to read as follows:

1 Landfill Management. Included in the rate structure listed
2 in K.C.C. 10.12.020 of this chapter is a ((~~\$15.08~~)) \$11.78 per
3 ton charge that shall be collected for each ton of solid waste
4 ((~~collected~~)) handled in the King County solid waste system which
5 shall be reserved to provide for the management, replacement
6 and/or reclamation of King County operated landfills in
7 accordance with K.C.C. 4.08.045.

8 SECTION 3. The effective date of this ordinance shall be
9 January 1, 1995.
