ORDINANCE NO. **11704**

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the conveyance of county road rights of way in the vicinity of SR 18, Issaquah-Hobart Road Interchange, and SR 900, May Creek Vicinity, located in council district 12, to the State of Washington.

STATEMENT OF FACTS:

King County is the record owner of county road rights of way together with all appurtenances thereto, together with easements held by King County, located within the highway project limits of SR 18, Issaquah-Hobart Road Interchange, and SR 900, May Creek Vicinity, all located in council district 12.

The improvement of SR 18 and SR 900 by the Washington State Department of Transportation makes it necessary and advisable for the State to acquire title to the county road rights of way for said highway projects.

Upon completion of the project, the State will quit claim deed these areas plus additional rights of way along the project area back to King County.

R.C.W. 47.12.040 and R.C.W. 47.17.727 authorize the State of Washington to acquire title to county road rights of way that lie within State highway projects by quit claim deed for a consideration of mutual benefits.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The King County executive is hereby authorized to execute the necessary documents to convey the county road rights of way, for mutual benefits, described as follows:

SR 18, Issaquah-Hobart Road Interchange

All county road rights of way, together with all appurtenances thereto, together with and to include, but not be limited to, all or various rights, titles and interests and easements that have inured to King County, located within the highway project limits of SR 18, Issaquah-Hobart Road Interchange, in Section 1, Township 22 North, Range 6 East, W.M.; Section 36, Township 23 North, Range 6 East, W.M.; and Section 31, Township 23 North, Range 7 East, W.M.

SR 900, May Creek Vicinity

All county road rights of way, together with all appurtenances thereto, together with and to include, but not be limited to, all or various rights, titles and interests and easements that have inured to King County, located within the highway project limits of

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SR 900, May Creek Vicinity, in Section 12, Township
23 North, Range 5 East, W.M.; and Section 7, Township
23 North, Range 6 East, W.M.

INTRODUCED AND READ for the first time this 27th day
