ORDINANCE NO. **11891**

AN ORDINANCE relating to the change of
name of King County Water District No.
127 to Fall City Water District.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Findings. The King County Council hereby
makes the following findings:

A. The Board of Commissioners of Water District No.127,
King County, Washington State, has determined that it would
be in the best interest of the district to change its name to
"Fall City Water District" since the district's current name
does not provide customers any geographical type of
identification, and making it more locally recognizable.

B. The district filed Resolution No. 784 with the King
County Council, resolving to change the name of the district
from King County Water District No. 127 to "Fall City Water
District".

1 SECTION 2. The King County Council, pursuant to RCW
2 57.04.065, approves the change in name of King County Water
3 District No. 127 to "Fall City Water District".

RESOLUTION NO. 784

A RESOLUTION approving the change of the District's name to Fall City Water District.

WHEREAS the Board of Commissioners of the District believes it would be in the best interest of the District to change its name from Water District No. 127 of King County, Washington to Fall City Water District; and RCW 57.04.065 authorizes a water district to change its name; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED that the District name shall be changed to Fall City Water District; and a certified copy of this resolution shall be delivered to the King County Council in the manner provided by RCW 57.04.065; and the President and Secretary of the District are hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver on the District's behalf any and all other documents necessary to carry out such change of name.
