ORDINANCE NO. **11922**

AN ORDINANCE relating to zoning; amending Title 21A to eliminate a conflict within definitions for accessory use repealing Ordinance 11621, Section 19 and K.C.C. 21A.06.012 and adding a new section to 21A.06.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 11621, Section 19, and K.C.C. 21A.06.012 is hereby repealed.

NEW SECTION. SECTION 2. There is hereby added to 21A.06. a New Section to read as follows:

SITE: A single lot, or two or more contiguous lots that are under common ownership or documented legal control, used as a single parcel for a development proposal in order to calculate compliance with the standards and regulations of this title.
